
The Board approved the September 2022 Board meeting minutes that are posted on our website.

## **New Business:**

• Supporting Umpire Calls: To ensure that we firmly uphold the "FUN" portion of the 3 main Vintage goals, it is very important for players on the field and in the dugouts to support the calls made by the umpires during the games. As always, the main objective is to get the calls right. However, there have been recent instances especially in the Tuesday/Thursday leagues where disagreements over certain umpire calls have broken out resulting in game delays and dissatisfied members. Therefore, players are strongly encouraged to support the calls made on the field by the umpires and if they do disagree with a call to take it up with their manager and not disrupt the game by starting an argument. If a disagreement does occur, the 2 managers will immediately get together for a quick discussion to resolve the issue so play can resume.

Ongoing complaining will not be tolerated, as it makes the game unpleasant for everyone else. Players causing these disturbances will be spoken to individually. If the behavior continues, more extreme measures, such as being removed from that day's games will be implemented. So just play nice!

This has been a very successful event for many years, and a way for Vintage players to give back, although participation is completely voluntary.
