

Minutes of the Previous Meeting:

The Board approved the October 2022 Board meeting minutes that are posted on our website.

Treasurer's Report:

There are a few outstanding questions that need answers before the Board approves the report.



Rules Committee Report:

• Pitchers Getting Behind Screens: In the last month 3 unnamed pitchers have been hit by batted balls due to not getting behind the screen after releasing the pitch. This is a very serious issue that, for a few pitchers who are not using the screen for protection, is not being remedied by current methods. Right now, we give pitchers a warning to get behind the screen after delivering a pitch. The Board approved a motion to formally warn the 3 pitchers to get behind the screen after releasing a pitch. A subsequent violation will result in a suspension for 2 weeks - from pitching only – to those who have already received a warning and then do not get behind the screen again.



Old Business:

- Fields Arcadia & Mise on Tuesday/Thursday: Mise wants to raise the fee to
 use the field by 4 times what we are paying now. Our "Field Negotiator" is
 working with the City of San Jose on a resolution so we can keep the price as is.
 We get to use Arcadia for about the same price as Mise, but they are much
 stricter about shutting down due to weather whereas Mise artificial surface allows
 for play even during a drizzle. Alternate fields in the area remain a possibility.
 More details to follow as they become available.
- Fields Arcadia on Saturdays: Dennis reports that information regarding play at Arcadia for 2 fields on Saturdays for about ½ the time starting in January 2023 is still being determined. More info to follow as it becomes available.

- **AED Battery:** Board approved \$400 for purchase of new battery.
